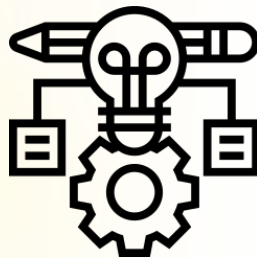

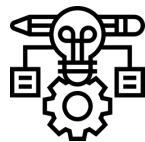

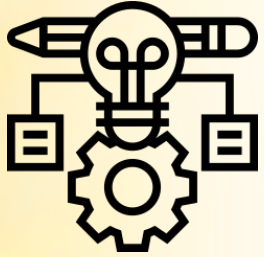
INNOVATIONS in EIEPC RESPONSES

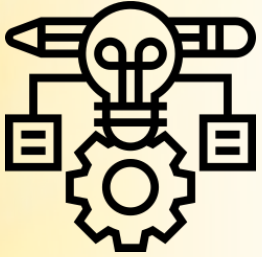

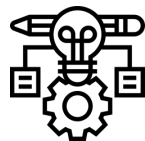
