Key corporate risks for ECW

1. We fail to achieve (and demonstrate) **quality** results for children and youth with the required **speed**
2. We fail to work together effectively and deliver as one to achieve results for children and youth
3. We fail to mobilize and provide the required resources to children and youth when they need them most



Key risk mitigation actions



1. (All) Strengthen ECW as a platform and deliver as one across the humanitarian/development divide
2. (All) Deliver results for children and youth with less bureaucracy and more accountability
3. (All) Innovate and disrupt beyond the old way of working
4. (All) Strengthen joint advocacy for a shared vision
5. (Secretariat) Focus on results and strengthen quality assurance
6. (Secretariat) Strengthen reporting on results and share lessons learned widely
