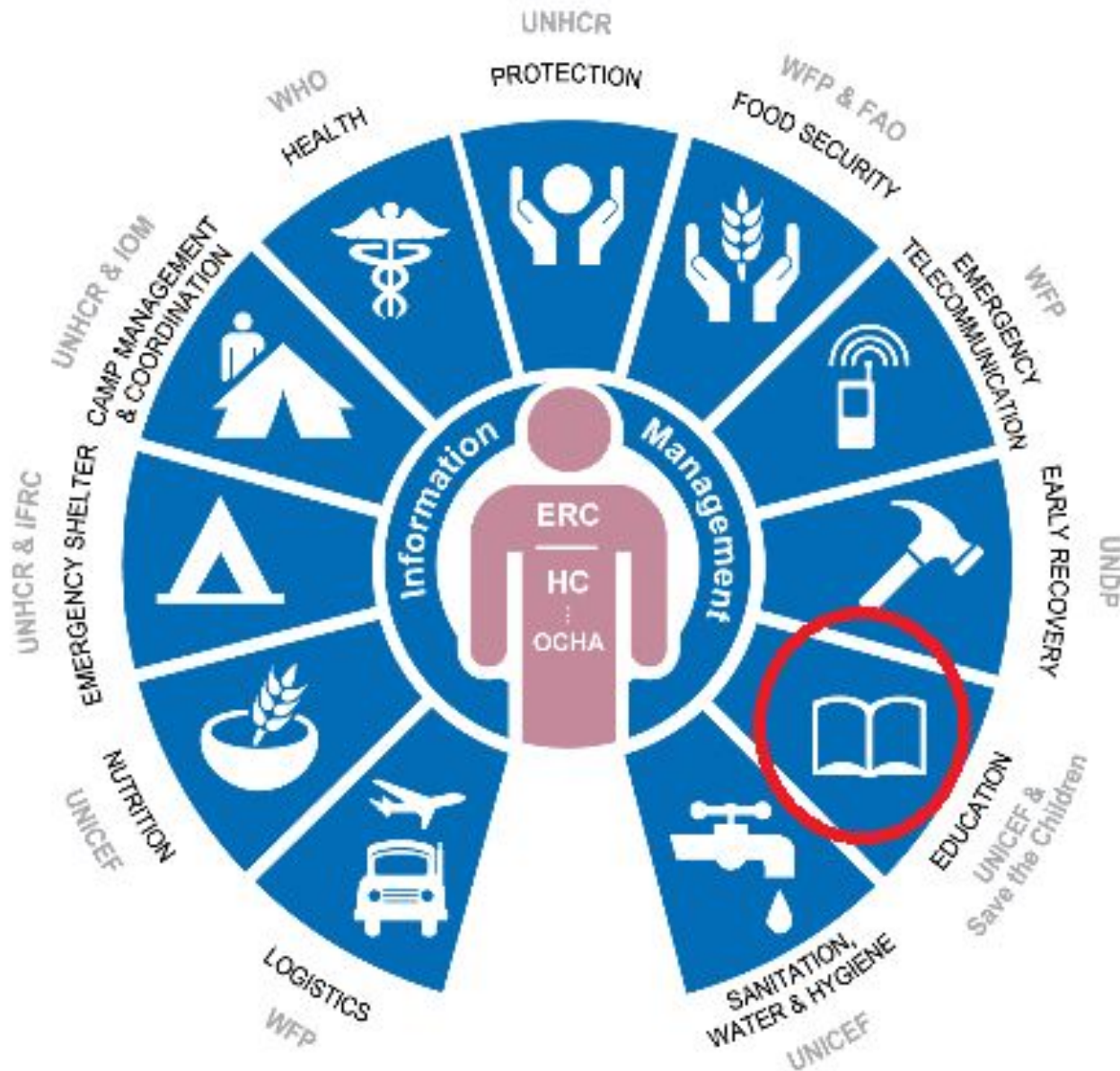
Results highlights

Children getting new learning materials	319,445	361,995	13%

Gender Strategy



- Gender Strategy finalized in April 2018
- Is a foundation for ECW program design, implementation and M&E.
- Basis for Partnership with lead organizations on Gender Equality for Girls and young women.
- ECW aims to reach 8 million children by 2021 of whom 50% girls.
- Prioritizes political commitment to address the needs of girls (G7 Declaration)

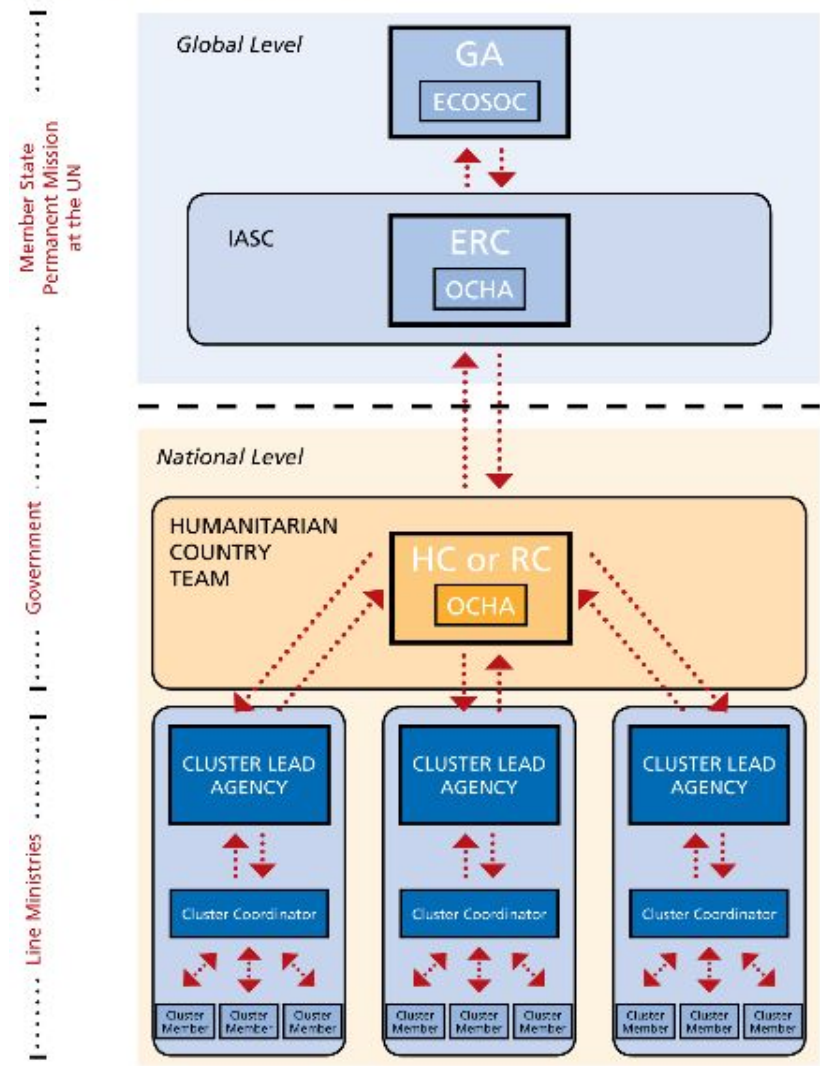

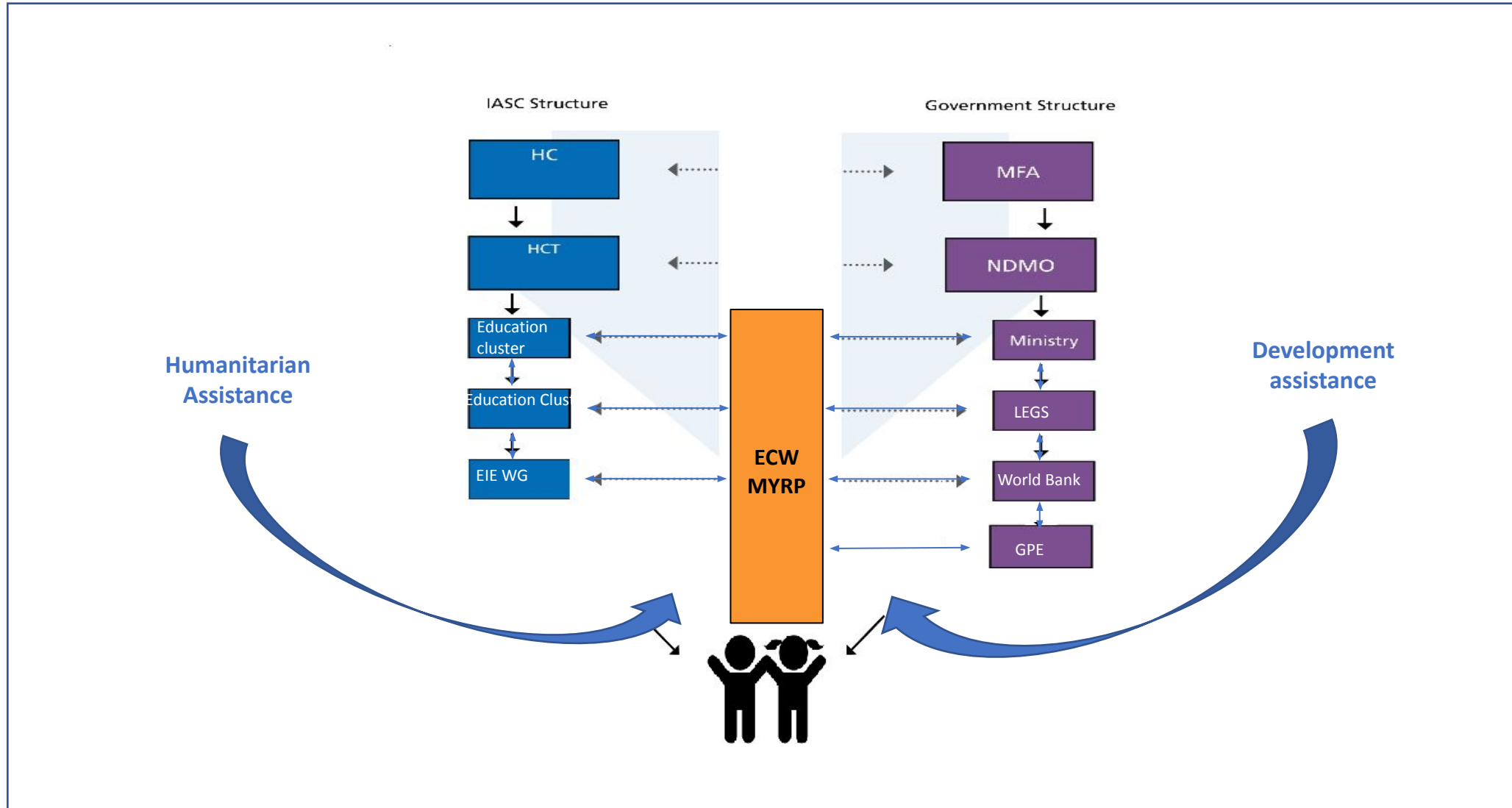
IAASC Humanitarian Coordination Architecture

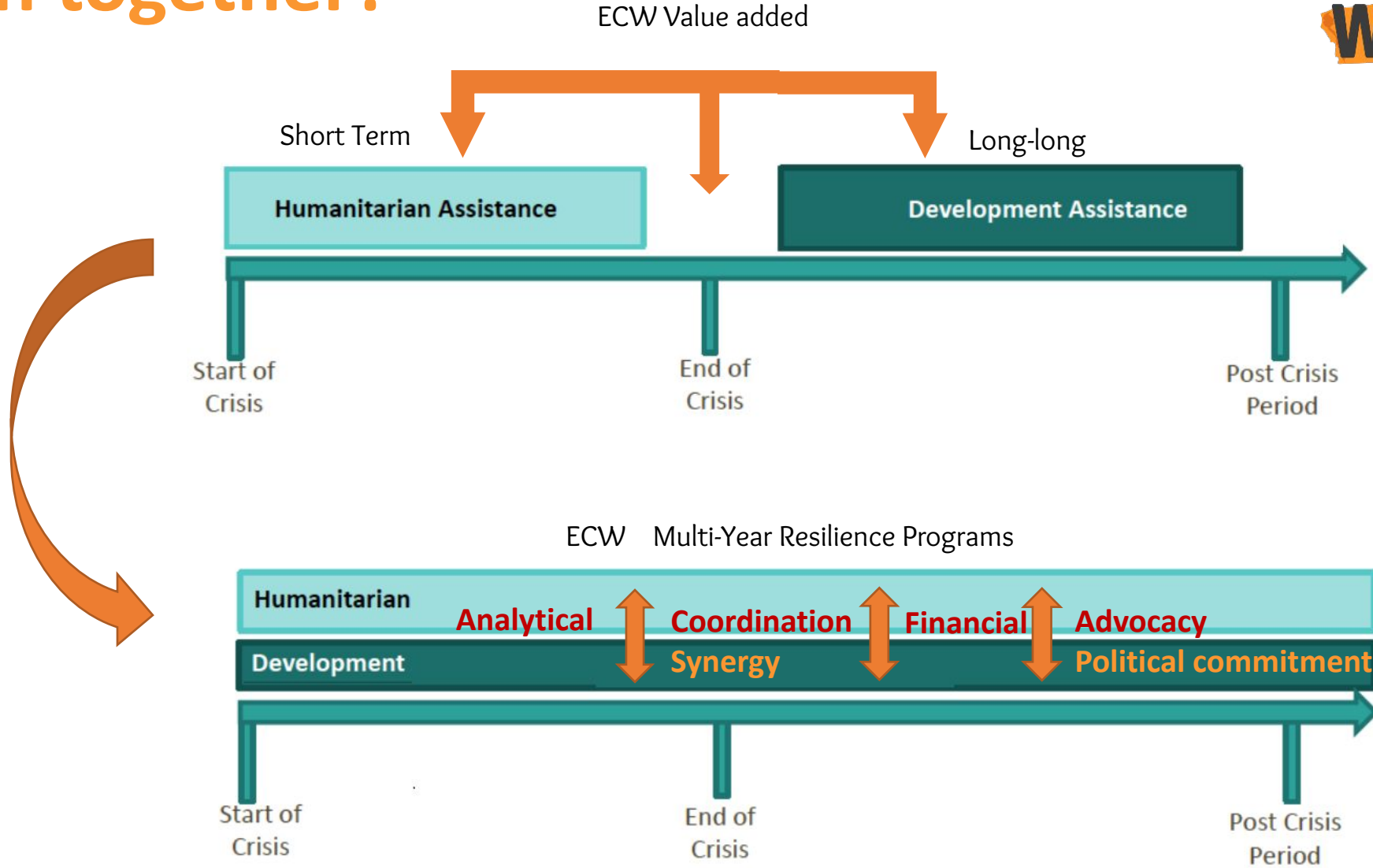

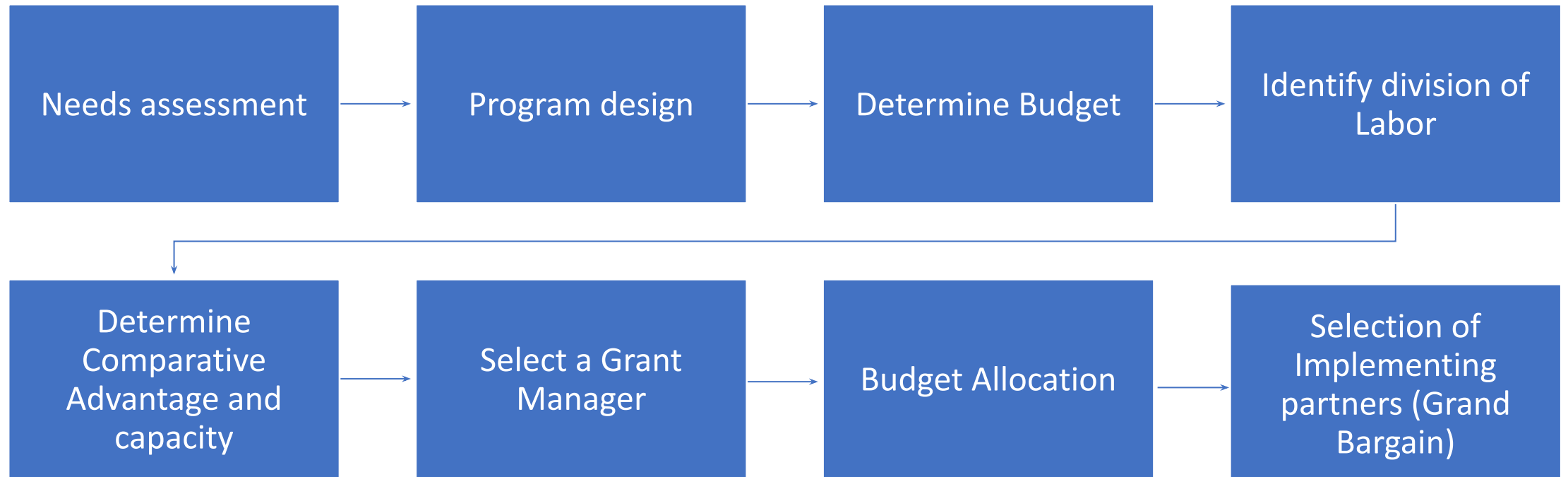
