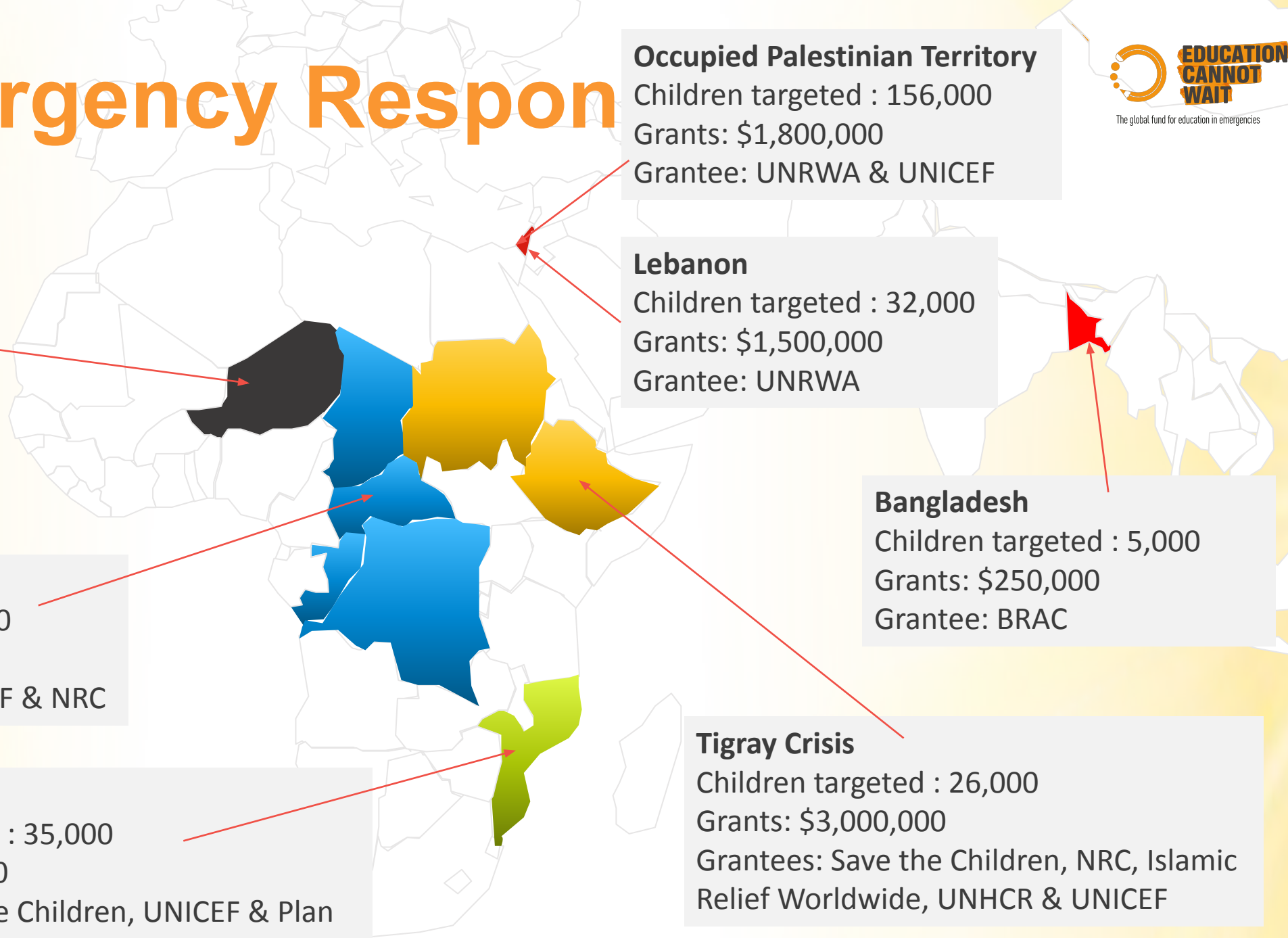

Over 300,000 children targeted (of whom 170,000 are refugees)



18 different grantees



\$13.5m in grants disbursed

MYRP Renewals

- **Bangladesh** – September submission to ExCom
- **Afghanistan** – postponed to 2022
- **CAR** – postponed to 2022 (no-cost extension)
- **Uganda** – costed extension (to align with ERP)

Acceleration Facility



\$8.4 Million– 2021 budget



18 different initiatives targeted across the AF strategy



70% of grants approved to date (12 grants), totalling \$3 Million
